Practice from the module:

Guide for Discussion:

- How have you recently received or given someone a holy greeting, attentive listening and/or a goodbye blessing that made an impact?
- Who is an example of holy hospitality that you might look up to? How/why?

Conversation Questions

- "You cannot judge Jesus and serve Jesus at the same time." Thoughts?
- Discuss this definition of hospitality: extending the privileges of community to those who do not have the standing to expect it, especially those who are vulnerable or are outsiders.
 - What example of Jesus' practice of hospitality stands out to you?
- How/why is hospitality a big deal to God?
- Taking the low seat: how does service or choosing your seat connect to holy hospitality?
- Who do you find it easy to invite to the table as family? Who do you find it difficult to invite and extend belonging to? Why?

Application:

- How can you act as a host when it's not even your house or party?
 - Do you believe you have that right? (remember Psalm 24:1)
- Who do you need to extend hospitality to?
 - Pray together for those people and make a plan for offering a greeting, attentive listening, a blessing or a meal.
